
UPDATED ACTIVITY REPORTS WITH PHOTOGRAPH REVISED NATIONAL TB CONTROL PROGRAM (RNTCP)

2016-17 to 17-18

1. <u>99 DOTS</u> for TB HIV confection was launched on 3rd Feb 2017: -

It is mobile phone based system for monitoring the treatment and follow up of tuberculosis among confected individuals with HIV. It was initially rolled out in ARTC Centres in RIMS & JNIMS. Now it has covered in all the ART centres of the state.



2. Launching of Active TB Case Finding by Hon'ble Minister of Health & Family Welfare, Manipur on 22nd July 2017: -

It is a provider initiated service to detect TB cases actively through house to house visit. The aim of the ACF is to detect all undetected TB cases in remote tribal areas, vulnerable groups like PLHIV, diabetes, geriatric home, orphanages, prisons, stone crushers, weavers etc. ACF was performed initially in 5 districts viz. Senapati, Thoubal, Bishnupur, Tamenglong & Ukhrul. In the 2nd phase 3 districts were covered in Churachandpur, Chandel and Imphal East. In the two phases of ACF, 67 TB cases were notified. More & more TB cases are expected to be notified through ACF in future.

3. Distribution of 27-two wheelers to the field staff of RNTCP: -

27- Two wheelers were distributed to the field RNTCP staff in all the districts of the state to supervise and monitor the RNTCP activities in the state.



4. Launching of Daily Regimen of anti-TB drugs on 25th October 2017: -

In order to provide uniform treatment of tuberculosis both in public and private sectors, intermittent therapy has been shifted to daily regimen with the advantages of (1) better compliance, (2) reduced relapse cares of TB.



5. Implementation of Schedule H1 on 17th November 2017: -

Private sectors take care of almost equal number of total TB cases. In order to enhance TB notification from private sectors, Schedule H1 was implemented in the state. With this, all the pharmacies selling anti-TB drugs have to report the details of the prescribers and patients. This data will be used for TB notification and follow up of cases.



6. Launching of Universal Susceptibility Testing (U-DST) in October 2017: -

In order to detect all the drug resistant TB (DR-TB) cases, drug susceptibility testing is done for all the newly diagnosed TB cases. With this, treatment can be made appropriate right from the beginning. CBNAATs are installed in all 9 districts of the state.

7. Arrival of Mobile CBNAAT van on 15th February 2017:

With its arrival, the CBNAAT (molecular technology, Cartridge based nucleic acid amplification test) can be utilized for camps, ACF and for other outreached areas.



8. Establishment of district Drug Resistant TB (DR-TB) centre at RIMS, Imphal West. With the establishment of DR-TB centre at RIMS, all the needy patients are admitted and treated, receiving specialized management of DR-TB patients.


