- 1. In continuation of order of even no. dated 11/06/2021 and in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 20(2)(a) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 the undersigned in his capacity as Chairperson, State Executive Committee of the State Disaster Management Authority, hereby prescribes the schedule of opening of vegetable vendors, grocery shops and wholesalers in respect of districts where "CURFEW" has been imposed as below.
 - i. Opening of local vegetable vendors from 7 am to 10 am for purchase by the locals on 16/06/2021, 19/06/2021, 22/06/2021, 25/06/2021 and 28/06/2021. The vegetable vendors should be seated at least 6 feet away from one another and should wear mask all the time.
 - ii. Only one out of three grocery shops of the total shops/vendors in one location shall be allowed to open on rotational basis from 7 am to 10 am on 16/06/2021, 19/06/2021, 22/06/2021, 25/06/2021 and 28/06/2021. If the shops or vendors are located in congested rows (on major roads like NH both sides may open), then only alternate rows shall be allowed to open. Queue system should be adopted by all shops and vendors.
 - Whole sale shops of grocery and food essentials located in Thangal Bazaar and Masjid Road will be allowed to open from 7am to 1200 noon as per schedule below:
